ORDINANCE NO. 500

REGULATING THE PARKING OF VEHICLES DURING CERTAIN MONTHS WITHIN THE TOWN OF BAVEN, SHERBURNE COUNTY, MINNESOKA

The Town Board of Supervisors for the Town of Haven, Sherburne County, Minnesota ordains as follows:

Section One - Purpose. The purpose of this ordinance is to provide for the safety and welfare of the citizens of the Town through the regulation of parking on town reads during periods when snow removal is required.

<u>Section Two - Definitions</u>. Any term used in this ordinance and defined in Minnesota Statutes Section 169.01 shall have the menaing given it by that section.

Section Three - Parking. A parking ban shall go into effect on November 15 of each year and shall remain in effect until April 15 of the following year. During a parking ban, no vehicle or moter vehicle shall be parked on any roadway in the Town.

Section Four - Violations.

- Subd. 1. Impoindment. The Countin Phrayiff or other person authorized by resolution of the Town Board of Supervisors may remove to a garage other other safe place any vehicle parked in violation of this ordinance. Such vehicle shall not be released until the fees for towing and storage are paid together with any fine imposed for violation of this ordinace.
- Subd. 2. Redemption. Within 24 hours after any vehicle has been impounded, the County Sheriff or other person authorized by resolution of the Town Board of Haven shall give written notice to the registered owner of the said vehicle stating the location at which the vehicle may be claimed, the procedure for redeeming said vehicle and the timeslimit in which the owner has to claim said vehicle prior to disposal. In the event the registered owner cannot be ascertained from State records, notice shall be mailed to all residents adjacent to the location at which the vehicle was found and notice shall be posted on the Town posting boards. Any vehicle may be redeemed by the owner by payment to the Town Clerk or other person authorized by resolution of the Town Board of Supervisors a fine of \$5.00 together with all fees incurred for towing and storage of said vehicle.
- Subd. 3. Disposition. Any vehicle not claimed within 14 days of the mailing of notice may be sold for not less than the amount provided for in subd. 2 to anyone desiring to purchase said vehicle.
- Subd. 4. Prima Facie Violation. The presence of any vehicle on any town road when standing or parked in violation of this ordinance is prima facie evidence that the registered owner of the vehicle committed or authorized the commission of the biolation.

Subd. 5. Penalty. Any person violating this ordinance shall be guilty of a petty misdemeanor.

Section Five - Severability and Repealer. All ordinances or portions of ordinances that conflict herewith are hereby repealed. Should any section of this ordinance be held unconstitutional or woid, the remaining provision shall remain in full force and effect.

Section Six - Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and publication in accordance with law.
